Our Candlelight Carol Service will be greatly shortened with a much smaller socially distanced Choir, fewer Choir carols, fewer Congregational carols and fewer readings. Please return as soon as possible to avoid disappointment.

This is so arranged to keep in line with Government rulings and those of the Presbyterian Church in Ireland.

If you have already attended our Morning Services you will see that many pews have been closed off and everyone present is recorded for safety measures. Everyone must wear masks at all times in the Church building and sanitise their hands on entering the Church. Only couples or family members are permitted to sit together and individual members sit safely distanced from the next person. Ushers show you to your seats, which are unlikely to be your usual seats and you are asked to stay seated at the end of the service until asked to leave. I hope these details will assure you of our best efforts to keep you as safe as possible.
