The McCracken Memorial Presbyterian Church seeks to employ a suitably qualified person to serve as its Director of Music. The person must be a skilled organist and experienced in choral direction. Along with providing organ music and conducting our choir, the Director will work to involve the entire congregation in meaningful musical expression, using traditional and contemporary styles.

The Director will be expected to lead music in worship at Sunday services. In addition, the Director will run a weekly choir practice September through to May.

The Director will work closely with the minister in planning services and musical programmes, but will be an employee hired by the Kirk Session and supervised through its Personnel committee. The first assessment/consultation will take place no later than six months from commencement, with subsequent meetings scheduled thereafter. The Personnel committee will not only supervise and make recommendations as to the position, but will seek to be a supportive body for the Director.

Though musical excellence is of primary concern, a crucial qualification for the position is inter-personal skills. The Director should be adept at introducing new music to the choir and congregation, and experienced in encouraging young and old to become more involved in worship through music.

We consider music to be an essential tool in building up the spiritual life of the congregation and in extending the Gospel to others, and we therefore seek someone in sympathy with the ethos of the Presbyterian Church. We have been blessed with an exceptionally strong musical heritage over 80 years. With the position of Director of Music, we hope to build upon our strengths – notably with organ and choir – and to stretch ourselves by extending musical participation in worship to a new generation and to a wider segment of our community.
